






FRONT INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Jack up the front of the vehicle and place on jack stands. Remove the front wheels.
- 2. Remove the front upper strut bolt using two 15MM socket/wrenches. See Photo 1.





Place the outer bracket on top of inner bracket (Photos a and b from page 2) and install in the stock upper strut location using 10mm x 55mm bolts and 3/4" x 0.9" spacer sleeve using two 17mm socket/wrenches.
See Photo 2, Photo 3, and Photo 4.





- 4. Drill through the lower hole in the bracket using a 5/16" drill bit. **See Photo 5**.
- 5. Install the supplied 3/8" hardware using a 9/16" socket and wrench. See Photo 6.



- 6. Reinstall strut in bracket using stock hardware.
- 7. Put on wheels and lower.






REAR INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Jack up the rear of the vehicle and place on jack stands. Remove the rear wheels.
- 2. Remove the rear upper strut bolt using two 15mm socket/wrenches. See Photo 1.
- 3. Install the rear brackets (Photo c from page 2) in the stock upper strut location with 10mm x 70mm bolts and 3/4" x 1.18" spacer using two 17mm socket/wrenches. **See Photo 2**.





4. Reinstall upper strut to the bracket using the stock hardware with supplied washers. See Photo 3.



5. Put on wheels and lower.

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
