






Installation of MBRP Hitch Receiver

- 1. The **Receiver Assembly** can be installed without removing the front bumper from the vehicle, but it is recommended to remove it for easier access to the mounting hardware.
- 2. Install the two (2) Socket Head Cap Screws (SHCS) and M8 Washers in the upper mounting holes from the inside of the vehicle frame. Mount the Receiver Assembly onto the (2) screws using Washers, Lock Washers, and Nuts. Hand-tighten the Nuts to hold the Receiver Assembly in place. Refer to Figure 1 and Figure 2.
- 3. From the front of the **Receiver** Assembly, install the two (2) **Hex Bolts** with the **M8 Washers** and **Lock Washers** in the bottom mounting holes. Securing the **Hex Bolts** on the inside of the frame with a **Washer**, and **Nut**. Hand-tighten the **Nuts**. **Refer to Figure 2**.
- *On older vehicles, it may be necessary to enlarge the lower frame holes by drilling with an 11/32" drill bit.
- 4. Verify that the **Receiver Assembly** is centred on the vehicle, then fully tighten the hardware (19ft-lbs/25Nm).
- *On some vehicles the head of the **BHCS** on the driver-side of the vehicle may be obstructed by the threaded end of the gearcase mounting bolt. If more access is required for tightening, loosen and back out the mounting bolt as needed.
- 5. Reinstall the front bumper (if necessary).
